**5** After this there was a festival of the Jews, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.


<sup>2</sup> Now in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate there is a pool, called in Hebrew<sup>[a]</sup> Beth-zatha,<sup>[b]</sup> which has five porticoes. <sup>3</sup> In these lay many invalids—blind, lame, and paralysed.<sup>[c]</sup> <sup>5</sup> One man was there who had been ill for thirty-eight years. <sup>6</sup> When Jesus saw him lying there and knew that he had been there a long time, he said to him, 'Do you want to be made well?' <sup>7</sup> The sick man answered him, 'Sir, I have no one to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up; and while I am making my way, someone else steps down ahead of me.' <sup>8</sup> Jesus said to him, 'Stand up, take your mat and walk.' <sup>9</sup> At once the man was made well, and he took up his mat and began to walk.


