We recall the words of the risen Christ: 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.' On the day of Pentecost, Peter preached the Gospel of Christ's resurrection. Those who heard the message asked what they should do.
