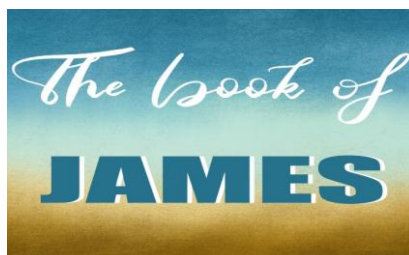
Bible Study at Chislehurst Methodist Church
