First Scripture Reading: MWB

We recall the words of the risen Christ:

'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'

On the day of Pentecost, Peter preached the Gospel of Christ's resurrection. Those who heard the message asked what they should do. Peter told them:

'Repent, and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ so that your sins may be forgiven; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is for you, for your children, and for all who are far away, everyone whom the Lord our God calls.'

Second Scripture Reading: Luke 1: 68-79

- 68 'Blessed be the Lord God of Israel, for he has looked favourably on his people and redeemed them.
- 69 He has raised up a mighty saviour[a] for us in the house of his servant David,
- 70 as he spoke through the mouth of his holy prophets from of old,
- that we would be saved from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us.
- 72 Thus he has shown the mercy promised to our ancestors, and has remembered his holy covenant,
- 73 the oath that he swore to our ancestor Abraham,
 to grant us 74 that we, being rescued from the hands of our enemies,
 might serve him without fear, 75 in holiness and righteousness
 before him all our days.
- 76 And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; for you will go before the Lord to prepare his ways,
- 77 to give knowledge of salvation to his people by the forgiveness of their sins.
- 78 By the tender mercy of our God, the dawn from on high will break upon[b] us,
- 79 to give light to those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.'
