Baptism is a solemn and important event, which invites us to be followers of Jesus Christ in our lives. The most important truth which baptism points to is that God's love comes first. God's love is there for us before we are born, before we are baptized. A child who has not been baptized is still loved just as much by God, but Baptism is God's invitation to declare and own that love.

In the Methodist Church we have a long tradition of baptising infants. On their child's behalf the parents promise to love and care for their child in

body, mind and spirit and ensure they are nurtured in the Christian community. The church congregation also promise to help the parents in this task.

Every child is a valued part of our church life and church members provide activities especially for children including a weekly junior church (Sunday mornings) and a monthly Messy Church (Saturday afternoons), which help the child to grow in grace and in the knowledge and love of God and of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

Our hall is also available for hire for refreshments / parties after the Baptism service.
